

Washington State History Contract

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Why do I need to complete the contract?

A: To graduate, Washington State requires students to complete a course covering the history and geography of Washington State. Students who have not satisfied the requirement in middle school or did not take Washington State history and geography previously need to fulfill this contract.

Q: If I attended a school from another state and completed its state history course do I need to fulfill this contract?

A: Not necessarily. Your school counselor will need to contact your previous school to determine if you satisfied the requirement.

Q: Will I receive credit for completing the contract?

A: No. However, by fulfilling the contract you will be eligible to graduate.

Q: When does the contract need to be completed?

A: Thursday, April 30th, 2009.

Q: Where do I turn in my work?

A: Submit your completed materials to your counselor. You can burn your work onto a CD or turn in a hard copy of the tasks listed below.

Q: What resources do I need to complete my work?

A: To complete the first task, you need to go to <http://www.experiencestatehistory.com/index.php> to access Washington: In the Pacific Northwest. Type wapnw as the username and password. Next click "Chapter Resources" then select a chapter from the drop down menu.
